

counsel, and for good cause shown;

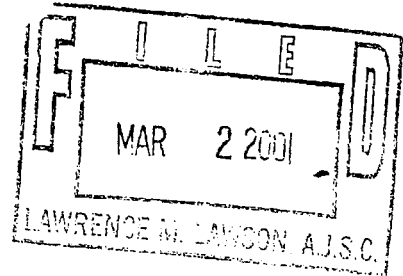
IT IS, on this 8th day of ~~October~~ ^{JANUARY} 2001, for the reasons more fully set forth
on the record on October 6, 2000, ORDERED:

- (1) The motion for reconsideration of the order denying a plenary hearing is DENIED.
- (2) Notes or minutes of the August 7, 2000, August 21, 2000, and September 5, 2000, executive session meetings of Defendant Township Committee shall be made available to Plaintiff no later than October 20, 2000. Plaintiff may make a further application for relief based on his review of those notes or minutes.
- (3) Notes or minutes of all other executive session meetings of Defendant Township Committee shall be made available to Plaintiff or any member of the public within 7 days from the date of the meeting.
- (4) Said notes or minutes may be redacted only to the extent actually necessary, in accordance with the Court's opinion set forth on the record.
- (5) No sanctions are imposed at this time.
